



How to Fight the Three Top Tire Killers

Statistics show the tires on the cars in North America are underinflated by an average of 10-15%. This leads to premature tire wear in all cases and is the reason underinflation is one of the top 3 tire killers.

Tire Killer #1: Improper Inflation- An 80,000 mile tire run even 5-6 lbs. low on air pressure, can lose 16,000 miles of wear.

- Tire inflation should be checked every 30 days to ensure proper levels. *Check pressure with the tires cold before extended driving.

Tire Killer #2: Failing to Rotate/Balance

- Failing to rotate and balance tires can shorten tire life by up to 50%
- Front Wheel Drive Cars are especially prone to this kind of wear
- Balancing may need to be done every 20,000 miles, check with your tire professionals at Walker Tire.
- Rotation should be done every 6,000 miles or every other oil change

Tire Killer #3: Vehicles out of Alignment

- Vehicles out of alignment will cause the tires to scrub and wear out prematurely.
- Alignment should be checked every Spring after "chuckhole" season.
- ALWAYS have the alignment checked when purchasing new tires.
